










Guidelines on EBSCO Host

EBSCO Host is a powerful reference system with databases that offers full text access to thousands of periodicals ranging from general reference collections to subject specific databases. Many students find **Academic Search Premier** database helpful for their information needs. To get to **EBSCO Host** go to --> **library homepage** (<http://www.lcc.hawaii.edu/lib/>) --> **Research and Reference** --> **EBSCO Host** --> **Complete Collection of EBSCOhost Databases**. If you are accessing from home, you must input your last name and UH ID number to be verified by proxy server.
